BOARD REPORT

- CornerHouse benefited from a Josh Hartnett Film Premiere Fundraiser with the screening of the movie *Hollywood Homicide*, raising more than \$75,000.
- CornerHouse held its Twelfth Annual Twins Fundraising Event, raising approximately \$72,000.
- CornerHouse staff published three articles in national publications.
- CornerHouse presented at four national professional conferences.
- Emergency weekend/holiday on-call interview services were initiated with the Minneapolis Police Department in 2003.
- CornerHouse extended its *Half A Nation by 2010* Training Program with the National District Attorneys Association's American Prosecutor's Research Institute (APRI) to ten states, to now include Minnesota, South Carolina, Mississippi, Indiana, New Jersey, Georgia, Missouri, West Virginia, Maryland, and Illinois. This program will see the CornerHouse-developed RATACTM Protocol replicated in 25 States by the year 2010.
- CornerHouse was identified and/or featured as providing expert services in Child Sexual Abuse Forensic Interviewing in one National Magazine and twenty-two local media forums, including newspaper articles and television interviews. This is in addition to the 23 media appearances and features from the Josh Hartnett Benefit Film Premiere.
- CornerHouse was the recipient of two resolutions by the Hennepin County Board for services and activities provided by CornerHouse that benefit the community.

Through all of this, nearly 1000 children and vulnerable adults were interviewed at CornerHouse, and over 150 children received medical evaluations.

Thank you for allowing me to be a part of such a vital group. As for my goal for this past year, I say, "Mission Accomplished!"

PROGRAM REPORT 2002-2003

Forensic Interview and Medical Services

In year 2002, 476 forensic interviews of children and vulnerable adults who were alleged victims or witnesses of violence were completed and videotaped. Also during the year, the multidisciplinary team reviewed 22 cases where no interview was conducted because the team determined that an interview would not be appropriate or the child was not available. The multidisciplinary team includes the CornerHouse Interview Specialist and Family Liaison, an assistant county attorney, and law enforcement and child protection professionals. Eighty-six sexual abuse medical examinations were completed in year 2002.

In year 2003, 494 forensic interviews of children and vulnerable adults who were alleged victims or witnesses of violence were completed and videotaped. Also during the year, the multi-disciplinary team reviewed 21 cases where no interview was conducted because the team determined that an interview would not be appropriate or the child was not available. Eighty-three sexual abuse medical examinations were completed in 2003 at CornerHouse.

Training Services

In the year 2002, CornerHouse trained a total of 759 professionals through its core training programs. In 2003, the number of professionals trained at CornerHouse was 729. These training programs included the CornerHouse Child Sexual Abuse Forensic, On-Site and Advanced training courses, as well as Mandated Reporter and Orientation training sessions. Mandated Reporter training sessions are designed for those professionals who are required by law to report child abuse. Two hundred twenty-six professionals attended this one-day training, and seven Mandated Reporter training sessions were held throughout the state of Minnesota.

One of CornerHouse's most exciting endeavors in the last several years is its collaborative venture with the American Prosecutor's Research Institute's (APRI) National Center for the Prosecution of Child Abuse called *Half a Nation by 2010*. The goal of *Half a Nation by 2010* is to establish a high quality, five-day forensic interviewing course based upon the CornerHouse forensic interview protocol in 25 states by the year 2010. Utilizing a train-the-trainer model, CornerHouse and APRI assist law enforcement and child abuse professionals, prosecutors and other multidisciplinary team members in each state accepted into the program to develop a customized, state of the art course, meeting the distinct needs of their jurisdictions. We are well on our way to a collaborative, systemic response to child abuse that elicits statements from children in a way that is developmentally appropriate, not leading or suggestive, and ensures the rights of the accused.

Staffing Changes

In 2002, CornerHouse added four new staff members to its team. Three additions included replacement staff for our Forensic Services Administrative Assistant, Business Specialist and Child Interview Specialist/Trainer positions, and a newly developed position of Training Coordinator/Child Interview Specialist.

In addition, Sharlene Shelton, CornerHouse Executive Director, resigned and accepted a position with Hennepin County's Community Health Department as manager of the Women & Children's Health Division.

During the first half of 2003, CornerHouse saw turn over for nearly half of its staff and subsequently added six new staff members to its team. The Board of Directors approved the restructuring of the organizational chart to more equitably assign supervisory and fiscal responsibilities, and added a Training Director and Business Manager to the Administrative Team. The Board also approved two new positions to meet the growing demands of CornerHouse; including a Family Liaison/Volunteer Coordinator and Video Technician.

Strategic Planning

The CornerHouse staff and Board of Directors completed a strategic planning process in the Fall of 2002. CornerHouse's new vision statement is "To maintain the highest quality intervention system for children alleged to be victims of abuse and violence." The new mission of CornerHouse is "To assess suspected child sexual abuse, to coordinate forensic interview services and to provide training for other professionals."

At the October 2002 Board Meeting, the following two goals were adopted for 2002-2005: 1) Provide the highest quality service to all populations that CornerHouse was originally developed to serve, and 2) Leverage the assets in the training program in order to continue to provide training on a national level. In addition, it was determined that ongoing analysis of funding issues would be crucial for the remainder of 2002 and the first half of 2003.

Collaborations

In addition to its strong collaborations with multidisciplinary team members within Hennepin County, CornerHouse has continued to foster its relationship with APRI to provide training services. Collaborations also continued with other children's advocacy centers in Minnesota, and memberships sustained with the National Children's Alliance, its State Chapter and the American Professional Society on the Abuse of Children. CornerHouse also successfully completed its accreditation process with the National Children's Alliance, and was approved as a member for another five years.

CornerHouse has been working closely with other social service agencies within Minneapolis to form the Minnesota Child Response Initiative (MCRI). The MCRI is a three-part initiative, focusing on intervention with children exposed to violence; systems change initiatives and a pioneering research study. The intervention component brings together community police officers, child mental health clinicians and domestic violence advocates to provide coordinated law enforcement and social service responses in order to change the lives of children exposed to domestic violence.

Summary

CornerHouse has undergone a number of changes in the last two years. Many staff, board members and collaborative team partners have committed renewed energy to our work on behalf of children. Staff, board and multidisciplinary team members have moved on from CornerHouse. New faces have replaced theirs, and new collaborations have been formed. Our techniques for interviewing children have undergone modification as new research and reliable interview methods become available.

CornerHouse envisions a community where children are protected from violence. Since its inception, CornerHouse has provided forensic services to over 7,000 children and provided training services to over 8,000 professionals in the fields of child protection, investigation, prosecution and human services. We have been privileged to train individuals from across Minnesota, 26 U.S. states, Canada, Russia, South Africa and Uruguay. With each passing year, the number of professionals trained to work with children using CornerHouse techniques increases. The number of children served who are allegedly abused and exposed to violence grows exponentially with each professional trained, and draws us closer to the day when children are free from violence.
