

Make Your Own Pinwheel!

Print this pattern and decorate or print the pinwheel artwork from page 2 of the PDF on the backside.

You will need a scissors, pencil, straw, and a paper fastener.

1. Cut the dotted lines around the square and from the four corners to the center circle. Try not to cut into the center area.
2. Use a sharpened pencil to poke a hole through the four tiny dark circles. The pencil point also works well to poke a hole into the straw. Carefully push the pencil point through the straw about 1/2 inch from the top.
3. Make the tiny holes on the four points meet at the center circle.
4. Push the ends of the paper fastener through the holes on the pinwheel. then push the fastener through the center circle.
5. Place the straw on the back side of your pinwheel and push the ends of the fastener through the hole in the straw. Open-up the fastener by flattening the ends in opposite directions.

Now you are ready to try out your beautiful pinwheel.

All you need is a little wind!
