CornerHouse Caregiver Support

What are CornerHouse Caregiver Support Services?

CornerHouse Caregiver Support Services help to assure families are supported, empowered, and connected to needed services through:

- Crisis support and advocacy;
- Education about child abuse, trauma, exposure to violence, and intervention systems;
- Referrals to community services;
- Information on crime victims' rights and crime victims assistance; and
- Continued support and follow up.

Who can use Caregiver Support Services?

Caregiver Support Services are available to the caregivers who accompany children to their interview at CornerHouse.

Do I have to participate in CornerHouse Support services?

Caregiver Support Services are **voluntary services**. Caregivers can choose to hear more about the services before deciding about participation, choose to accept services later in the process, or can discontinue services at any time.

Will receiving Caregiver Support Services impact my investigation?

No. CornerHouse Caregiver Support Services are completely separate from Law Enforcement and Child Protection investigations.

How much do Caregiver Support services cost?

Caregiver Support Services are free of charge to the children and families served by CornerHouse.

How do I access Caregiver Support services?

Caregiver Support Services are offered to accompanying caregivers at the time of the forensic interview. A member of our Family Services Team will be available to meet with you while your child is interviewed and to follow up with you by phone or email to answer questions, connect you to needed services and support you and your family.
