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CornerHouse Home Visiting Program

What is the CornerHouse Home Visiting Program?

The CornerHouse Home Visiting Program includes weekly home visits. The services are tailored to the needs of your family and may include:

- Help in supporting your child and family with any issues resulting from the trauma experienced by your child
- Crisis counseling
- Information on child development and positive parenting strategies
- Linkage to community resources, such as therapy and assistance for crime victims

Who can receive the Home Visiting services?

The Home Visiting Program is available to families of children who have been interviewed at CornerHouse and meet the program's qualifying criteria.

Will receiving Home Visiting services impact my investigation? No. The CornerHouse Home Visiting Program is completely separate from the Law Enforcement and Child Protection investigations. Investigators can refer families to the program, but a family's participation is completely voluntary.

How much do Home Visiting services cost?

Home Visiting services are free of charge to the children and families served by CornerHouse.

*In what languages are Home Visiting services provided?*Home Visiting services are provided in English and Spanish.
